

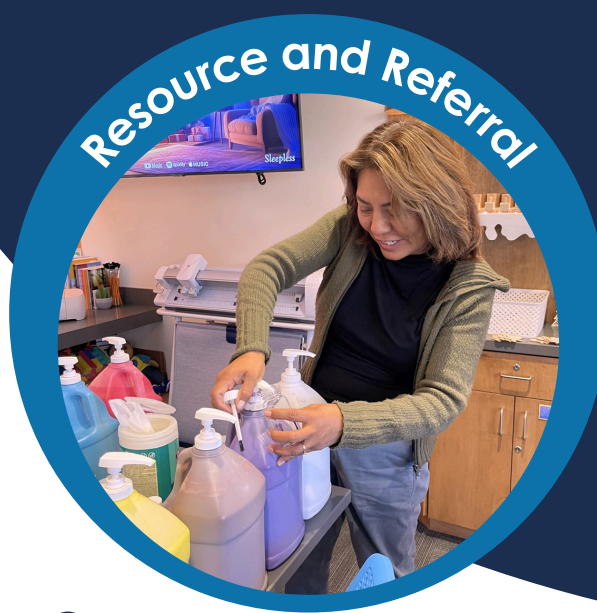
What is Resource and Referral?

Resource and Referral (R&R) is a core service that started at the conception of Crystal Stairs, Inc. as a non-profit agency in 1980. Crystal Stairs started a Toy Loan Project that would be the genesis and foundation for what we now call the Resource and Referral Early Childhood Education (ECE) Resource Center.

Our founders identified early that locating child care for parents was extremely fragmented and desired to be part of the solution.

Our mission is to help parents find appropriate child care; to assist family child care homes and centers in offering quality child care; to promote a child care system that meets the needs of the community.

With a diverse array of child care providers, thousands of referrals to parents, and numerous support services, all services are provided at no charge to families and ECE professionals, and available in English and Spanish.

CHILD CARE INITIATIVE PROJECT (CCIP)



Child Care Initiative Project (CCIP) is a statewide initiative to build the supply and improve the quality of licensed family child care homes. The program recruits, trains, and retains licensed family child care homes within our service area.

- CCIP participants include one or more of the following:
- License-Exempt: Family, Friend, & Neighbor (FFN), Caregivers caring for children whose families receive child care subsidies
 - Individuals interested in becoming a Family Child Care Home (FCCH) Provider who are working towards licensure
 - Licensed FCCH Providers interested in expanding capacity

FAMILY, FRIEND, & NEIGHBOR (FFN) "PLAY AND LEARN" PLAYGROUP

The monthly Family, Friend and Neighbor (FFN) Playgroup is a safe place for children ages 3-5 and their caregivers to learn and grow together. TRUSTLINE



TrustLine is the California registry of in-home and license-exempt child care providers (babysitters and nannies) who have passed a background screening.

In California, license-exempt providers who receive a state or federal child care subsidy, except grandparents, aunts, and uncles, are required by law to register with TrustLine.

UNIVERSAL PREKINDERGARTEN (UPK)



Universal Prekindergarten (UPK) is an initiative to expand early care and education choices for 3 and 4 year old children. Choices include Child Care Centers (licensed programs in a school-like setting), Family Child Care Homes (licensed programs in a home setting), and Transitional Kindergarten (a program for 4 year olds offered at most elementary schools).
